The inaugural **Tour de PIF** offers 2 cycling courses to cater for all levels of experience. Both routes take cyclists through some of Sydney's most picturesque scenery with roads meandering through virgin bushland capturing some spectacular water views along the way.

YOUR CHOICE OF ROUTE

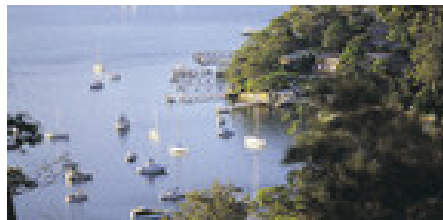
The Majestic Hawkesbury – 120km / estimate 5–7 hours

This course takes riders from Bayview through Ku-ring-gai Chase to Hornsby, over the Hawkesbury River via the Old Pacific Highway, climbing Mt White, dropping into Mooney Mooney then making your way to Ettalong where cyclists will board chartered ferries to Palm Beach. From Palm Beach, cyclists continue the journey back to Bayview along the northern beaches coastline. This is a challenging course for experienced riders. There are 3 climbs aggregating to 1400 metres. Very experienced riders can add the Bobbin Head Gorge loop. Overall a very challenging ride of 5-7 hours.

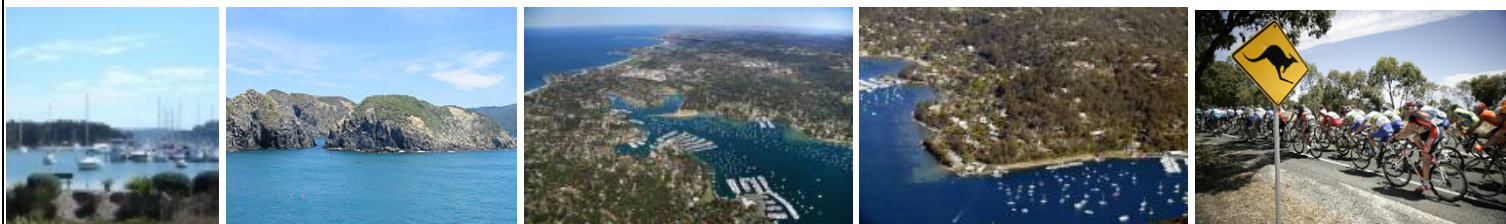
Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park - 50km | estimate 2-3 hours

This is a shorter course which takes riders from Bayview along the shores of Pittwater through Church Point, climbing into Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park for the journey to West Head. Marvel at the amazing views at the West Head Point lookout before returning along the waterfront to Bayview. For those not accustomed to riding in this area, you will experience one significant climb and a series of rolling hills with an aggregate climb of 960 metres. A challenging ride of 2-3 hours.
