Welcome to the 2nd PIF Annual Charity Cycling Challenge | Tour de PIF.

The Property Industry Foundation presents its 2nd **Tour de PIF 2011** offering three (3) cycling courses to cater for all levels of experience – 32km, 62km and 130km. The courses the Planning Committee have chosen this year take cyclists through some of Sydney's most picturesque scenery, with roads meandering through bushland capturing some spectacular water views along the way.

Included in the entry fee of the PIF Charity Cycling Challenge, is a function within a national park. Cyclists arrive at Bobbin Head – **Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park**, at the same time our Car Challenge members complete their navigational course.

Both groups come together to socialise and network for a relaxing afternoon comprising a gourmet BBQ and open-air bar, plus there are great raffle prizes too. The afternoon includes an Official Welcome by the Committee Chairman and Major Sponsor, together with trophy and raffle prize presentations.

Cyclists are welcome to invite their family members to join them at the Post-Challenge function which includes family activities such as face painting and children's games. (The additional participant's fee is \$25pp)

While the event will be fun, there is a serious side too. The Property Industry Foundation has committed \$60,000 to sponsor two part-time counsellors at the Police & Community Youth Club (PCYC) *City of Sydney* at Woolloomooloo. The Foundation previously provided a \$125,000 donation for the refurbishment of their club's youth facilities.

Click here for how to get there</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Entry to the National Park is via the official gates (green gates). Gates open at 6.00am. ✓ Parking is not available in your entry fee. National Parks all day parking costs \$11; can pay via cash and credit card – unless you have a National Parks Permit. ✓ The Registration Desk is The Station picnic pavilion next to the environmental centre, nearby the Bobbin Inn, and managed by a team of PIF volunteers. ✓ Toilets are in this immediate area – ideal for changing. ✓ It is understood that <u>sunrise</u> will be at 6.45am. Lighting will be available to ensure efficient processing. ✓ A health bar, Gu and water for each cyclist is included in your entry fee, and will be available at Official Registration. ✓ A map showing the three courses will be distributed to each cyclist. ✓ Your memorabilia <i>Champion Systems</i> wind vest will be distributed from baskets <u>according to size</u>. ✓ It is a condition of Tour de PIF that you must wear your event branded wind vest. ✓ The <u>Bobbin Inn Cafe</u> will be open from 6.30am for those who would like to start their day with a great coffee! The Rules

1. All cyclists are required to wear the Property Industry Foundation wind vest. Other cycling gear can be company or personal branded.
2. All cyclists must wear a helmet.
3. This is NOT a race.
4. All cyclists must observe the road laws and speed limits on the courses.
5. All cyclists must conduct themselves in an orderly manner.
6. When a bicycle lane is marked on the road, cyclists must use it.
7. Cyclists are to avoid large peletons being formed; no more than two riders there abreast.
