## PIF speeds up fundraising efforts

The Property Industry has announced a record fundraising result from its Car Rally Challenge, raising \$30,000 for young people in crisis.

Sixty cars participated in the PIF's fourth annual Car Rally Challenge, sponsored by Thiess, Davis Langdon and Hastie Group.

Beginning at The Mean Fiddler at Rouse Hill, the Rally followed a driving route on public roads leading to a secret destination with clues and cryptic driving instructions given at each checkpoint.

In the Corporate Division construction group Ganellen took out the title, with edwardjames in second place and Rice Daubney in third.

Proceeds from the Car Rally Challenge will go to the Sir David Martin Foundation current building project to support the work of the Triple Care Farm, which fosters an environment of peace and healing for troubled youth.
