**Hammer to fall for homeless**

The Property Industry Foundation (PIF) is again hosting a charity auction in affiliation with leading real estate firms to raise more than \$20,000 net for Sydney's homeless youth. This year the auctions will be held from October 10 to 21 at auction rooms across Sydney, including the *Sydney Morning Herald* Auction Centre, Pitt Street, with participating agencies donating their auction registration fees to PIF. CB Richard Ellis, Colliers International, Cushman & Wakefield, Jones Lang LaSalle and Knight Frank will auction a range of properties including commercial and retail spaces. Money raised will go towards the Girls' Brigade and Boys' Brigade. Last year's event raised \$18,677 for the Youth Services Centre for Barnardos in Penrith.
