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It's a wrap

SIXTY volunteer members of the Property Industry Foundation will wrap 1000 woollen clothes packages to be distributed around Melbourne this week via charities Open Family Australia, Salvation Army, Lighthouse Foundation and Citymission.

PIF, which formed 15 years ago in Sydney and branched into Melbourne in 2008, mobilises available property industry resources to assist youth services charities. It currently raises about \$1.5 million annually.

PIF patrons include Professor David de Kretser and

Professor Marie Bashir, Governor of New South Wales.

Arthur Daley's Clearance House, catering company CNK Food Design and building services and engineering group WSP Lincolne Scott are the biggest donors to the PIF winter campaign known as Chocs for Socks. Gloves, scarves, beanies and socks will be distributed around Melbourne this week.
