Property industry rally for charity

Registrations for the Property Industry Foundation's (PIF) 2010 Annual Charity Car Rally are now open, with the event to be held on Sunday, August 22.

The Car Rally has expanded this year to include a Cycling Challenge, with over 100 bikes expected to participate.

The fifth annual Car Rally and Cycling Challenge aims to raise \$50,000 for homeless and disadvantaged youths, with proceeds going to the Sir David Martin Foundation, which provides care and rehabilitation support services for crisis-affected youth.

PIF has pledged a total of \$515,000 to the Foundation for numerous projects.

This year the Car Rally follows a route along Sydney's Northern Beaches. Participants will be given a series of clues and cryptic driving instructions to complete the course.

The cycling component of the event will have two options, with participants choosing between a 50 or a 130 km course.

The Car Rally and Cycling Challenge starts at the St Ives showground and will have a number of checkpoints along the way. Last year's Car Rally raised \$30,000.
