As the Regatta is about youth homelessness and building homes, we have invited Tamara to be the face and voice of young people who live at risk or are homeless.

She successfully completed our Youth Sailing Program in 2017, and will guide other young people in the program in 2018.

Tamara’s mother was addicted to drugs and so at 6 months old she was taken into foster care. “I’m not sure how many foster families I had,” she said. At age 17, the relationship with her then foster family broke down and they asked her to leave. Without anywhere to go and friends unable to take her in, she slept in a car.

Tamara said she now has the support and direction she has been looking for all her life. “Without the fantastic support I received, I’d still be living on the streets,” she said.

Building homes for young people
